Dear resident,

Update: Proposed organic waste facility in Lidcombe

I am writing to give you an update about the development application for the proposed organic waste facility at 109A Church St, Lidcombe (DA2023/0130).

On Wednesday 16 August, during a Cumberland Council Meeting, Mayor Lisa Lake moved a Mayoral Minute requesting the General Manager prepare a draft submission to the Sydney Central Planning Committee to oppose the proposal.

The Mayor also noted that the residents raised the concerns about the need for a proper written notification for development applications such as this. She has asked the General Manager to undertake a review with respect to the written notification of requirements for development applications of designated developments.

The Council planning team is now finalising the assessment for the development application. Once a decision has been made, the application will then be sent to the Sydney Central Planning Panel for a final decision.

The Sydney Central Planning Panel will host a public forum to collect feedback from residents. I will let you know once we have more about information about this forum.

As the local Federal Member of Parliament, I will be making a submission to the Sydney Central Planning Panel to express the local community's concerns with this proposal.

Thanks to all the residents who participated in the process and made submissions. I would also like to thank Mayor Lisa Lake, Councillors Kun Huang, Sabrin Farooqui and all councillors for their tireless advocacy on this issue.
