I would like to express my strong objection to the proposed construction and operation of an "organic waste transfer station" in Lidcombe.

Our LGA is already being used as a waste reservoir in several locations. Household, building, medical and even radioactive waste are all being processed or stored in our suburbs.

And now a proposal for a rubbish tip in our neighbourhood?

A dirty, smelly, noisy rubbish tip within 70 meters of homes. Homes with people, pets and gardens.

A rubbish tip that will be serviced by 118 large trucks per day. Trucks 20 meters long clogging and endangering the local streets and polluting the environment.

A rubbish tip has no place in the middle of a suburban area.

Maybe the land can be better used. The thousands of people about to inhabit the new highrise apartments just few meters down Church Street would probably appreciate some green space.
