Hello. My name \_\_\_\_\_ and I am 53 years old. It's been 20 years since I moved to Lidcombe, and I live in a comfortable residential life. My greatest desire is to live here in Lidcombe for the rest of my life, especially because I work here and my communities set up in Lidcombe are priceless to me. The Korean community has built up a strong foundational base here in Lidcombe, and it has become the most desirable centre in Sydney for Korean people. It has everything we need: shops, restaurants, hospitals, train stations and excellent bus services. Lidcombe is the jewel of the West: hence, I was utterly shocked and felt a great sense of disappointment and betrayal at the news of the proposed rubbish tip. Thus, I **strongly object** to the construction, set-up and operation of the proposed rubbish tip in Lidcombe.
