Dear Assessment Officer Fay Ong,

I am writing to express my strong concern about the proposed development application **DA2023/0130** for an organic waste facility in our community. While I understand the importance of managing organic waste sustainably, I believe that this particular proposal is not suitable for our neighbourhood due to its potential negative impact on the environment and the quality of life of local residents.

My main objection to this development application is the issue of smell. As we all know, organic waste tends to produce a strong odour when decomposing, and this can be extremely unpleasant for those living nearby.
