Dear Cumberland Councillors,

I have recently been made aware of Development Proposal DA2023/0130.

I am extremely concerned about the negative impacts this development will have on Lidcombe residents and am writing to express my strong objection to the Development Proposal outlined in DA2023/0130 (Demolition of existing buildings and construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station).

There are a number of externalities with the Development Proposal that will greatly impact local Lidcombe Residents.

These include:

- Traffic congestion

There is already heavy traffic congestion from Church Street through to Railway and Arthur Streets due to the construction of new highrise apartments along Church Street and the surrounding areas. The construction of the proposed organic waste transfer station would severely exacerbate this problem.

- Road Safety

Lidcombe is gentrifying at a fast pace and is home to many young families (my young family included). The increase in heavy vehicle traffic associated with waste transportation would be detrimental to the safety of children and pedestrians in our local area.

In light of the concerns raised above, I request that Cumberland City Council re-evaluate the approval of Development Proposal DA2023/0130. The adverse impacts of having an organic waste transfer station in Lidcombe outweighs any benefits to local residents.
