I am writing to formally object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church St Lidcombe NSW 2141 Lot 1 DP778492 (File DA2023/0130).

Lidcombe is a quiet, densely populated residential area, and it is home to predominantly families with young children. We have apartments being built and new apartments will continue to be built for the area to support future population growth. We strongly object to the construction of an organic waste transfer station, as this will adversely impact property prices and cause traffic congestions in and around Lidcombe. Importantly, it will lead to an unacceptable level of noise and pollution for a densely populated residential area.

Therefore, our grounds for objection are as follows:

- 1) Unacceptable traffic congestion.
- 2) Unacceptable levels of noise and foul smell.
- 3) Dust fumes and pollution.
- 4) Proliferation of rodents and other pests.
- 5) Reduction in property prices.
- 6) Deterioration in long term health and wellbeing of Lidcombe's residents.

Please can you decline this development proposal on the basis of the above objections.
