According to recent information, the government will build a waste collection point on Church St in Lidcombe. As those of us who have lived in Lidcombe for many years, we felt compelled to express our objections as residents to the government.

1) The selected location poses a safety hazard to traffic.

Because that road section is the main passage for Lidcombe residents to go to the east, it is

not suitable for a large number of large vehicles to stop and enter and exit. In this narrow road

section with sharp bends, there have been car accidents caused by avoiding large vehicles.

2) The selected location is too close to the residential area.

It is not suitable to choose a site here from the perspective of sanitation and noise, and it is

predicted that it will cause continuous disputes in the future.

3) It will cause traffic jams in the area.

Due to the existence of the railway line, this section of the road is already busy.

Increasing the

flow of large vehicles will congest the east-west road connecting M6 and M3, causing unnecessary social costs and detrimental to the reputation of the ruling party.

The above three points are our attitude towards the construction of new recycling stations, and the Government should carefully consider them. Thanks!
