I am writing to strongly object to the proposed development outlined in DA2023/0130 as a long-term resident of Lidcombe. The proximity of this development, only 70 meters away from our residential zone, raises significant concerns regarding its potential impact on the health and well-being of our community.

One of my primary concerns is the potential health risks associated with the proposed development. The noise pollution generated by the project would greatly affect our ability to sleep, leading to adverse effects on our health and well-being. Additionally, the environmental pollution from increased traffic would pose risks to our overall health.

Furthermore, the proposed location's unsuitability becomes even more apparent when considering its proximity to places of worship, schools, and residential areas. Preserving the sanctity of places of worship, ensuring a safe and healthy environment for school children, and maintaining the environment of our residential areas should be of utmost importance.

In light of these concerns, I urge you to prioritise the well-being, safety, and liveability of our community. Please reconsider approving DA2023/0130. Living 1km away from the proposed development, I am concerned about the potential negative impacts it would have on the quality of life in our neighbourhood.
