I would like to object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 .
File: DA2023/0130 .

An organic waste transfer station would cause more traffic congestions, due to the large amount of trucks that would be coming into Lidcombe. Parking around the train station is already full and congested, especially with the many apartment buildings being built next to it.

The noise, dust fumes and bad smell from the trucks and the organic waste from the transfer station, would impact the environment, the health of residents, and overall quality of life. Decrease in property value could also be a possible potential risk, if the waste transfer station is developed.

Roads and roundabouts will be damaged by the ongoing heavy vehicles entering. Repairs and maintenance would then be required, which Council would need to attend to. The possibility of rubbish falling or flying off trucks is a reasonable possibility, even if there are policies regarding covering truck loads. The reality is, not all trucks that are entering Lidcombe will be adhering to those policies.
