Dear Cumberland Council,

[REDACTED] and I am writing this email to let you know that I am very strongly against the 'Demolition of existing building and construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station' that was summarised in DA2023/0130. As a resident of Lidcombe and a nature lover, I believe this proposed project will impact our general balance of ecology.

One of the concerns for this project would be the effect of the traffic congestion. Especially, I believe the people who [REDACTED] St. are already straining local road infrastructure, increasing Church St traffic volume including the train. For that reason, the vehicle relating to the waste transfer would carry out further negative impacts such as longer queues, slower traffic and delay in emergency reaction.

I have been living in Lidcombe for seven years and I am quite concerned about noise and air pollution.

To sum up, I hope the Cumberland Council to reappraise this project to ensure residents' safe and convenience. I expect to see prompt action towards this email.
