Re: Objection to Proposed Organic Waste Transfer Station, 109A Church Street, Lidcombe

I write to formally express my strong objection to the proposed Organic Waste Transfer Station (rubbish tip) slated for construction at 109A Church Street, Lidcombe.

As a resident of the immediate area, living merely [redacted] from the proposed site, I am greatly alarmed by the potential negative impacts such a development will have on our community. These include serious health risks, environmental pollution, increased traffic congestion, and the proliferation of pests.

Living in close proximity to a rubbish tip exposes residents to harmful gases and other pollutants, potentially leading to an increase in disease rates among local residents. Furthermore, the operation of such a facility is highly likely to attract vermin and pests, posing a health and safety risk.

The expected rise in vehicular traffic associated with the facility's operations could lead to significant traffic congestion, particularly given the site's close proximity to a densely populated residential area. This congestion will not only be inconvenient for residents but could also lead to an increase in road accidents and reduce the quality of life for residents.

In essence, placing a rubbish tip near a residential area, especially one as new and vibrant as ours, significantly devalues our investments in our homes and negatively impacts our daily lives. It is my firm belief that such facilities should be located far from residential areas, where they pose fewer risks and disturbances to everyday life.

I kindly urge the Cumberland City Council to reconsider the placement of the proposed Organic Waste Transfer Station. Such a decision should be taken with the full agreement and consideration of the local residents whose lives will be directly affected.

I look forward to your prompt attention to this matter. If there are any public meetings, hearings, or other opportunities for residents to express their views on this proposal, I would appreciate being informed.
