I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing as a concerned resident in response to the proposed Organic Waste Transfer Station to be located at 109A Church Street, Lidcombe.

I am deeply concerned that the installation of such a facility so close to the newly built apartment complex where I reside, and other residential areas, will lead to a plethora of issues. This proposed location is merely 180 metres away from our homes, a proximity that I and many others find alarming.

The proposed rubbish tip, due to its very nature, is likely to cause significant disturbances in our community. The daily operations of such a facility involve heavy traffic of waste disposal vehicles which will certainly cause traffic congestion, particularly in our small community streets. The station will inevitably generate noise, odour, and air pollution which will negatively affect the living conditions in our neighbourhood.
