I am writing this email to put forth my objections to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130 .

This is due to the negative impacts which I foresee regarding the livability of the suburb of Lidcombe, along with the specific reasons as follow:

1. The proposed DA site is close to residential properties, schools, nursing homes, parks and businesses.
2. Church street is a single lane road and cannot afford waste transfer trucks going around the neighbourhood, which will add traffic congestion, noise and air pollution. And increase the likelihood of hazards and accidents for local residents.
3. The organic transfer station will produce a bad smell, attract rats, cockroaches, pests and rodents.
