Im writing to complain about Rubbish TIP in Lidcombe:

Traffic congestion: Lidcombe's central area already faces severe traffic congestion. Bringing in large trucks constantly in and out of waste and dumps between 6am and 10pm Monday to Friday (plus long hours on Saturday) will undoubtedly exacerbate the problem. The presence of these large garbage trucks will hinder traffic on already congested roads, causing further inconvenience and delays for commuters, residents and pedestrians.

Additionally, congestion caused by parked trucks in the middle of the road will exacerbate pollution levels, creating additional health hazards for Lidcombe residents and passers-by. The safety of children, in particular, will be at greater risk due to dangerous road conditions due to increased traffic congestion.

The developer's report did not take into account traffic issues outside the 200-meter radius of the proposed dump. With the recent construction of new condominiums anticipating a surge in the number of residents, traffic conditions will undoubtedly undergo a profound shift. Therefore, the city council must consider the future situation and focus on improving the current traffic situation instead of exacerbating the traffic situation due to the continuous influx of large garbage trucks.

The developer's report failed to add to the potential impact on recently built condominiums near the proposed dump and other nearby residents. Noise pollution from the operation of waste and refuse centers has a serious impact on the quality of life of other residents living in and around these apartments. Disruptions from noise pollution can lead to sleep deprivation, increased sleep levels, and an overall diminished sense of well-being. This detrimental effect on the pH and mental health of residents cannot be ignored.
