Dear Cumberland Council,

Greetings of Peace and hoping everyone is doing well in your good office. I am writing you this email to express concerns about the proposed waste transfer facility to be built on 109A Church St. Lidcombe.

A lot have already been said about the negative effects and consequences of the proposed application such as:

- environmental odour and pollution leading to negative health effects
- long term effects on the youth and children
- build up of environmental pollution due to risks of mishandling waste
- traffic congestion and noise
- location proximity to schools, churches, agedcare/daycare centers, medical centres, and parks
- very close proximity to residential areas
- etc.

With the above, It is not in the best interest for the Lidcombe neighborhood to have a waste transfer facility built here. It would also have a more broader socio-economic and possibly political impact such as:

- it will unlikely attract more people to move, reside and invest in our neighborhood which will impact the local economy
- it will discourage the masses to use Lidcombe as a strategic entry point to Sydney Olympic Park
- it will discourage visitors to frequent the small korean establishments which we known for
- property values will decline, businesses will slow down, crime rate may go up, overall status of Lidcombe as a suburb will degrade
- the neighborhood will also lose confidence in our leaders including the council, impacting future elections, council reputation, the masses' sentiments, etc.

Overall, having a waste transfer facility built in Lidcombe would be detrimental not only to the public but also to the suburb.
