I would like to submit my objections to the proposed waste transfer station going to be built at 109A Church St, Lidcombe. So called " WASTE TRANSFER" actually it is PUTRID.

The proposed location is right in a residential area, only less than 200m away from the newly built "The Lidcombe Rise" apartment. It's unfair, and discriminatory that our previous Auburn Council Community, is targeted to bear the burden of this dirty industry. That proof again since we merged into Cumberland Council became a stepmother's child.

The traffic congestion is bad in the surrounding proposed location now, then plus hundreds of large garbage trucks enter and exit the transfer station every day, the narrow street and bridge, will become a car park.
