To Whom it May Concern

I am writing to express my strong concern and objection to the proposed rubbish tip in 109A Church st Lidcombe.

I am an owner and occupier of my home on [redacted] which is within 1km of the proposed tip. My children attend the local school which is also within 1km of the proposed tip. I also work at the local aged care home on [redacted] which is only 600m from the proposed tip. I have no doubt the **smell and fumes emitted from the rubbish and transport** of rubbish will reach my home, my children's **school**, and the vulnerable elderly residents at the **aged care home**, most of whom already have **chronic respiratory illnesses**.

The **traffic and road congestion** on John st and Church st is already terrible. This proposed tip will just make it worse, **significantly increasing noise and air pollution** from trucks.

This is a **major health and safety issue**. Not just for the hundreds of residents within very close proximity to the proposed tip but also to the thousands of Lidcombe residents within 3km of the tip. There are also several **childcare centres near church st and also sports and recreation facilities parks and centres** that will be impacted on either side of the railway near the tip. You also have those newly built high rise apartments along the railway, further increasing traffic congestion. Why would someone want to live in these new units when it is within 100m of a tip? Why would you purchase a unit from this block or any other home in Lidcombe for that matter if this goes ahead? **impact on property values** is another factor which needs to be considered.

I sincerely hope my objection is seriously considered.
