I would like to object to this application. To build a waste transfer station in Lidcombe with ventilation stacks. The waste facility can not be built within 400m of residential areas.

Application Number DA2023/0130.

These types of waste stations produce odour and gases, it can attract pests, ie: rats, birds and other wildlife in the area. There will be increased noise and odours from trucks travelling to and from the transfer station.

There have been reports and complaints in the past of odours from the Minchinbury organic waste in western Sydney.
