I have been a resident in Lidcombe for past 8 years.

I'm writing to object to the development of the proposal outlined in DA2023/0130 for construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station.
I wish to express my strong opposition to this development proposal.

I believe this proposal is detrimental to our neighbourhood and the well-being of our residents.

The biggest concerns I have for this proposal is the potential impact on the traffic congestion in our community. The development proposal failed to take into account the construction of new homes in 4-34 Church St. The influx of people living in these newly constructed homes has already put a large strain on local road infrastructure as well as traffic on Church St via Railway and Arthur St.

The development is likely to further exacerbate the existing congestion on Church, Railway and Arthur St specially on the A3 motorway.

The traffic associated with waste transportation will further heighten congestion resulting in longer queues, slower traffic, long waiting queues, emergency response times as well as impact the safety of public especially pedestrians and cyclists in the area.

I would like to suggest the Cumberland Council to assess the traffic generated by the new dwelling at 4-34 Church St and the cumulative impact of this proposal on an already strained road network. I urge you to conduct a comprehensive reassessment that consider the cumulative impact of this proposal. It is imperative that any potential adverse impacts on traffic flow and congestion are thoroughly considered and mitigated. Moreover, it is vital that we prioritise the protection of our natural resources and thorough environmental impact assessment is to be conducted to assess the potential consequence of this product on our neighbourhood and beyond.

I trust the Cumberland Council will carefully reconsider these objections and take the necessary steps to address the concerns raised by residents like myself.
