Dear Sir/Madam, I wish to object to planning application DA2023/0130: Demolition of existing buildings and construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station.

I have been living in Lidcombe for 20 years and am writing this letter to object to this permit being granted on the ground of the proximity to residential areas and the effect it will have on air quality in town.

The impacts on my health due to noisy, contaminated air and odour have not been demonstrated the Whole Life Residents were carried out within the application.

No information seems to have been distributed to inform the impact of the proposal on the health and well-being of the children who will be growing and playing in the area.

It is my understanding that no consultation or explanation was provided which demonstrated the need for an organic waste transfer station in the heart of residential areas.

The plan if approved, will be affected more by traffic congestion which is already a huge problem with multiple high-density residential developments in the Lidcombe.

The introduction of a waste transfer station at this point of the road will be severely detrimental to free traffic flow.

A travel plan will not address this issue and it cannot be mitigated by any measures.

I believe that you would listen to my concerns and will take action for me.
