> I am writing to express my objection to this proposal for a number of reasons.
>
> If the waste transfer station gets built:
>
> The large number of trucks that will be coming from all directions through residential streets which were not built for heavy vehicles.. Rate payers will be responsible for repairs.
>
> The waste station will be used by councils across the metropolitan area so transport and waste will be coming from all ways through Lidcombe streets.
>
> I have concerns regarding the added traffic potential impact of traffic congestion in the community.
> Considering the current development of units in Church Street, including affordable and public housing will place a strain on traffic on Church Street through Olympic Drive to Arthur Street.
>
> The proposed hours of operation go significantly over the Development Control Plan.
>
> A waste station should not be built in a residential area, it is approximately 70 metres from houses. I'm sure there are more appropriate sites in industrial areas.
