Development Application DA2023/0130 - Organic Waste Transfer Station

I am writing to you today to oppose the construction of the proposed organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street, Lidcombe.

I am opposing based on the following:

- Excessive increase of heavy vehicle traffic through township to transport and transfer waste to and from waste station
- Further road congestion as the location is not built to sustain heavy traffic
- Increased road maintenance is required due to heavy usage impacting residents and businesses
- Excessive heavy vehicle noise
- Increase pollution from heavy vehicle
