**Development Application DA2023/0130 - organic waste transfer station in Lidcombe**

Residents in Lidcombe have raised concerns with me about the proposed organic waste transfer station on Church St, Lidcombe (DA2023/0130). I am making this submission to relay those concerns to Council.

I have received a significant amount of correspondence from residents concerned by the impacts the proposal will have on the local community. On Sunday 9 July, I hosted a mobile office at Phillips Park in Lidcombe for residents to share their views and around 150 residents attended.

Residents' concerns around the proposal include:

- excessive traffic congestion on local roads caused by additional waste transfer trucks;
- the risk of unpleasant odours from the site and concerns about the impact this proposal will have on the local environment;
- excessive noise being created; and
- a significant reduction in the quality of life for nearby residents;

I urge Council, and the relevant decision-making authorities to take these concerns into consideration and would greatly appreciate it if Council can keep my office up to date with the progress of this proposal.
