It has come to my attention of an Organic Waste Transfer Facility being proposed in Lidcombe Church St. This facility will operate daily Monday – Friday (06:00-22:00) with 47 trucks of 20meter in length accessing this facility. This excludes staffing capacity and cars at the site.

With this proposal in a heavily density populated area will have high impact to the limited infrastructure to support the increased in traffic capacity and noise.
