I make the objection to building the proposed rubbish tip (Organic Waster Transfer Station) on 109A Church Street, Lidcombe, NSW 2141. I am an older resident in Lidcombe for over 13 years and my father is 90 years over. English is my second language. So this email is interpreted by my daughter Zheng Yan whilst I am expressing my reasons for objection to this proposal verbally.

The reasons for objections are as below:

1. Environment impaction such as air, noise, soil pollution
2. Over cloudy traffic cause car incidents and local or nearby local residences inconvenience such as extra limited road car parking spaces, and the school children's morning dropping time on Mary Street which is only the street behind Church Street.
3. Impact the residents' health and well-being.
4. Local residents will bear the cost of roadworks damage by ongoing heavy garbage trucks or other huge vehicle usage in this area.
5. Negatively affect local commercial, new apartment (The Lidcombe Rise on 36 Church Street, and Kee Lidcombe on 18-24 Railyway Street) property company and their employees, and recreational environment.
6. The bad presence of local property value decrease in this area and lose interest in the business partnership at a further time. For example, the local restaurant will close because of the smell, or dust reasons, or customers lost interest in this area so no jobs required will increase this area I believe.
