Dear Cumberland City Council,

I strongly object to the proposed development of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street, Lot 1 DP 778492. File DA2023/0130.

The proposed installation site will adversely affect the Lidcombe residents. Waste transfer trucks will bring on traffic congestion and reduce pedestrian and driver safety in the area and cause significant noise and unpleasant odour.

There is already very busy traffic on Church Street Lidcombe due to the construction of new apartments, and an increase in traffic related to the proposed waste station would exacerbate this existing issue.

Cumberland should be a lovely place to live. However, a waste station and the continuous movement of waste transfer trucks will deteriorate the quality of life in our neighbourhood. We should be thinking of creating assets which would make the Cumberland area an attractive place to live. So we cannot understand how our community will benefit from this project especially if it causes ill health of our residents. The safety and peace of our neighbourhood should also be prioritised over such a development.

I implore the council to consider the negative impacts on the community set out in this letter when assessing the DA.

I strongly believe that a waste transfer station does not belong in our community, and I request the Council to reject this proposal in the best interest of Cumberland residents.
