To whom it may concern,

I am writing this email in objection to the development of the organic waste transfer station in Lidcombe.

As someone who has grown up in Lidcombe as well as frequently accessing the road that this site is proposed for development, I must say it is a poor choice to develop a waste station on that site/location. Firstly, the road itself is already packed full of mostly idle large trucks on both sides of the road which create a very narrow road for cars to safely drive through, further development and congestion of the area with large trucks will cause further hazard and chaos for local residents and passing traffic.

Additionally construction of a waste station located within a close vicinity of housing, pedestrian area as well as a fairly frequently accessed road will negatively impact the wellbeing of local residents: If possible, I believe the station could be situated in more remote areas where the health of residents, flow of traffic and safety will not be compromised.
