Dear Cumberland Council

As a long-term resident of Lidcombe, I am writing to strongly object the development proposed in DA2023/0130 for a new organic waste transfer station on Church St, Lidcombe.

The few reasons for my objection are as follows:

- The high probability of bad odours from the site to nearby residential area.
- Increased traffic from trucks transporting waste in and out of Lidcombe residential area, and also further congestions around Church St.
- Reduced health and safety for residents nearby the organic waste transfer station i.e. less safe to walk in the area especially on the roads with increased truck traffic, potential smell from truck carrying waste, and from the site itself.
- High possibility of increased noise from the waste transfer station for nearby residents especially given the proposed hours of operations.

I request that Cumberland Council strongly consider the above matters and obtain the appropriate environmental assessment, as well as listen to the voice of Lidcombe residents in regard to this development proposal.
