), resident of Lidcombe for the last 22years, submit my objection to the above mentioned proposal. I put my objection based on the following reasons:

## 1. Traffic Congestion

We (my family and I) use Church Street/Railway Street to goto Homebush West/Choullara/Strathfield frequently for various reasons. That's the best route to get to those places. Recently we have noticed few heavy vehicles have parked on either side of Church street, where

the proposed development will take place. I believe, if the development proceeds there will further more heavy vehicles will pass through that section to make traffic congestion. Also, once the residents move into "Lidcombe Rise" 6 blocks of apartments with 20 floors each,

it is anticipated even more vehicles will use this corridor. Furthermore, trucks wanting to reach this facility will be coming through streets which are already congested and residential areas.

2. Dust fumes, bad smell and increased noise

In addition to the bad smell coming out of the proposed plant, trucks carrying waste will be travelling through the residential areas to reach this plant. Hence, Lidcombe air will be polluted with bad smells and dust. Due to the proposed operational times of the plant, it can
