I would like to object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130 .

My objections are as follows:

- 1. The proposed site for the DA is in close proximity to residential properties, schools, nursing homes, parks, and businesses.
