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To Cumberland Council,

I would like to object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130 .

My objections are as follows:

1. The proposed site for the DA is in close proximity to residential properties, schools, nursing homes, parks, and businesses.
2. Church Street is a narrow, single-lane road that cannot accommodate waste transfer trucks circulating in the neighborhood. This would significantly increase traffic congestion, noise, and air pollution, and pose a greater risk of hazards and accidents for local residents.
3. The organic transfer station would emit unpleasant odors and attract rats, cockroaches, pests, and rodents.
4. The release of hazardous fumes and pollution would have a detrimental impact on the health, well-being, and quality of life of local residents.
5. Stormwater runoff from the facility could contaminate the local sewage system and pollute the land.
6. The project would have adverse environmental effects, including air pollution, soil pollution, and noise pollution.
