### Background

Cumberland local Council is proposing to build a rubbish tip (Organic Waste Transfer Station on 109A Church Street Lidcombe (DA2023 /0103) which is less than 100 metres away from our local residential properties, and is also close to schools, Child Care, Aged Care, Parks and Businesses.

The proposed operational times are every Monday to Friday from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm, from 8:00am to 6:00 pm on Saturday. 59 large garbage trucks with a length of 20 metres will enter and exit from our Lidcombe streets, resulting in 118 truck movements every day.

If the waste transfer station gets built, this would have a significant impact on the residents currently living near the proposed construction site and the rest of the neighbourhood with:

Traffic congestion

Air, noise, and soil pollution

Dust fumes and bad smell

Negatively impact to tranquillity of our suburb

Negatively impact the health and safety of local residents

Negatively impact property values

Negatively affect residential, commercial, and recreational environment

Local residents will bear the costs of roadworks damaged by the ongoing heavy vehicle usage of the area.

**REASON FOR OBJECTION :**

I moved into this apartment last June. The reason why I came to Lidcombe is that I am happy to teach children every Saturday in St. Joachim's Primary School. But if there is an organic waste transfer station, my happy days will be depressing with smell, pollution, and noise. Is this just me??
