To Cumberland Council,

I am writing to express my strong objection to the proposed construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492, as outlined in File: DA2023/0130.

I have several concerns regarding this proposal, which I believe will have detrimental effects on our community:
