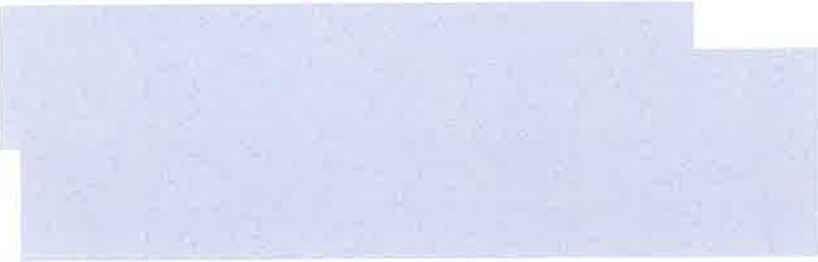

The following is my objection to Development Application DA2023/0130:

As a resident in Lidcombe, NSW 2141, I am writing this email to strongly against the following Development Application DA2023/0130.

Industrial - Extension of Notification until 14 July 2023 - Demolition of existing buildings and construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station. Integrated Development - Section 43(b) of Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997. The proposal is Designated Development under the provisions of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021

The following are my reasons of my objections:

1. This application will bring more than 100 heavy vehicle travel in and out in a residential area which bring road noise and unsafe road traffic to adults and children live in this area.
