To Cumberland Council,

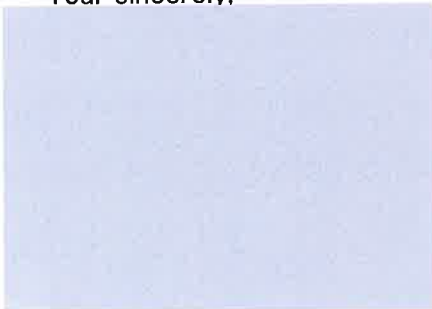
I would like to object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130.

This is due to the following reasons:

1. The proposed DA site is close proximity to residential properties, schools, nursing home, parks and businesses.
