I am writing this letter to express strong opposition to the proposed development outlined in DA2023/0130, which involves the demolition of existing buildings and the construction and operation of a local community waste disposal facility.

As member of a concerned resident in Lidcombe and advocate for environmental preservation, I believe this proposed project will have a detrimental huge impact on our neighbors, residents' well-being, and the overall ecological balance.

One of the most urgent concerns regarding this proposal is the potential impact on traffic congestion in our community.

The current traffic impact report, which is part of the development proposal, has failed to consider recent housing developments in the vicinity, particularly the development at 4-34 Church Street.

The influx of residents in these newly constructed homes has already burdened the local road infrastructure and increased the traffic volume on Church Street through the railway and Arthur Street.
