Because this area is getting busier every year by by-passing traffics through Bachell Ave to church street to olympic drive. We moved here from West Pennant Hills in 2014, at that time the traffic was not busy at Bachel Ave. Now the traffic is so busy at rush hours. If the high rise apartment will be completed, the more traffics will run through Church Street through Bachell Ave to Centenary Drive , Olympic Drive and East Street, James street, Joseph Street. It is a, ready full capacity to absorb all the by pass drives. When all the house holds move into the newly being built apartments more than 500 house holds has to use these roads. Plus 118 20ton trucks should drive this roads every day from 6:00 am till 10:00 pm , then what will happen to this area do you think? 118 truck movements divide 16 hours means every one hour 7.375 trucks move. This means again every 8 minutes 1 truck pass these streets. Do you know Church Street is mostly apartments built street. More population than house area. Even though 109a Church is zoned as industrial this block is so closed to the Church Street newly built apartments within 50m approx. My house is located very close to this DA area.

Our business i [REDACTED] This also so close to the waste transfer station. Because my business has been in Lidcombe since 2005 that is why we moved from West Pennant Hills so nice woody clean suburb to Lidcombe due to our oldness. I regret so much that I moved to this area because you council never take care of Lidcombe. Who can think it would be built such smelly toxic waste transfer station in this approximate 50-100 meters away residential area? Without madness how can they plan to build such ugly toxic waste in this area?

I strongly request not to permit that DA 2023/0130 as titled subject. You should not ignore us, most residents are multicultural background. Just because of one millionaire thousands of residents may lose their value of the property and the Lidcombe itself would lose its development trend. I am Korean Australian. Lidcombe is vibrant Korean town. Many Korean businesses and house holds are moving from Every suburbs to here. If this news spreads around Sydney these movements would stop and people who live here also want to leave. You council also would lose your reputation and will face lots of damage on various parts of your operation.
