I strongly oppose to the proposed DA2023/0130, Site: 109A Church St LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492.

I am writing to express my strong opposition to the proposed rubbish dump in our residential area, specifically only 100m away from residential properties. As a member of the community who resides in Lidcombe, I am deeply concerned about the potential negative impacts this development will have on our neighborhood.
