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Dear Councillor,

[REDACTED] and I have been a resident of Lidcombe for 27 years. I live with my mother who has a weak immune system.

I am writing to express my strong opposition to the development application DA2013/0130. This application proposes to construct a waste transfer station at a location within 100 meters of residential areas.

I am opposed to this development for the following reasons:

- **Traffic:** The transfer station is expected to handle up to 118 trucks per day, which will pass through residential and commercial areas of Lidcombe. This will lead to increased traffic congestion and noise. The noise and traffic will be a serious nuisance for me and my mother, and it will also make it difficult for us to get around.
- **Odour:** The odour from the transfer station will spread to residential and commercial areas of Lidcombe. This will lower the quality of life and reduce property values. The odour will also be a severe health hazard for my mother, who has a weak immune system.
- **Location:** The transfer station is located within 100 meters of residential areas, which poses a threat to the health and safety of residents. The transfer station will attract pests and rodents, which can pose a serious health hazard to my mother and other residents.
- **Potential future tip work:** The transfer station can handle all types of waste, which increases the likelihood that the transfer station will be expanded to a tip in the future. This will have a significant impact on the residential and commercial areas of Lidcombe.

For these reasons, I urge the Cumberland Council to reject development application DA2013/0130. I believe that this development will have a negative impact on the health and safety, environment, and quality of life of residents.
