- 1 Air quality High Risk revised to low risk through the use of wet scrubbers and chemicals.
- Odours are airborne and do not stop at 250 metres. My residence in has been impacted by odours from the Auburn waste facility located at Old Hill Link and it is over 2 kilometres away.
- 2 Leaching Moderate risk revised to Low risk. Risk assessment reduced by a management plan.
- Chemicals generated from the input Waste (both Organic and Non Organic) and Chemicals used for cleaning and odour control leaking into Lidcombe's soul and stormwater.
- 3 Traffic Management Moderate risk revised to Low risk. With over 118 truck movements per day. How is this so? With additional housing apartments, meaning more people and traffic. Seriously!

The EIS states that all traffic exiting the site must turn left, heading east (away from Lidcombe). The traffic management plan indicates traffic entering the site from both directions. This will impact the traffic towards Lidcombe centre.

An independent traffic impact assessment report required.
