Hi Cumberland Council,

I would like to object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organ waste transfer station at 109A Church Street, LIDCOMBE, NSW 2141. Lot 1 DP 778492. File: DA2023/0130.

I have been living in Lidcome for more than 10 years. It is a really nice and developing suburb with a lot of potential where more and more small business shops, new apartments, shopping centers are now showing up in the area. The public transport is extremely convenient as well. I am feeling so proud that the local council has done a great job for developing Lidcome last 10 years.

However, we recently are advised there is a waste facility proposed in the area. This is really going to be a disadvantage to us. As we know, Lidcombe station has got 5 transport lines which makes Church Street always crowded and it will become more crowded due to the new apartments going to be completed soon along Church Street. I strongly do not expect more heavy vehicles in and out which will cause more traffic congestions in the future.
