I would like to object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130 .

I am a mother of a young baby that would be directly impacted from the construction of the organic waste station as it is barely 200m from where I am living.

I am highly concerned with the impact all the noise and pollution will have on myself and for my child. The impacts it would have are only negative and I don't see any benefits of having such a facility so close to residents.

It is quite alarming that this is even being considered. I had thought that any such proposal would have been immediately rejected.

For a busy street that will be even busier with the massive apparent building across the road I can't even begin to imagine adding this facility what it would do to traffic.

Once again, I would like to voice my objection to such a facility from being built.
