My name is _____ I. I am writing to you to voice my objection to the organic waste transfer station that is planned to be built at 109A Church St LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778942.

My main concern about the waste transfer station is that it will cause obstruction to the road. Church St is already a very busy road, as it is one of the exits onto the A3. With the construction of the apartment happening on Church St along the railway we can already see the congestion we could be expecting.
