I am emailing my concern regarding the proposal for Lidcombe waste transfer station. I was looking forward to moving into my new home in Lidcombe next month, however was devastated to hear the proposal for building a waste transfer station near my apartment. I would like to emphasise that this would impact so many areas such as:

- traffic issues: the truck movements would have to cross through the residential areas and would create more traffic when coming from all areas around Lidcombe.
- quality of the road network: I am concerned that our roads, roundabouts and even our vehicles would be more at risk and be damaged.
- odour: there is no absolute reassurance that the odour will be controlled as the trucks will be buffering the odour when travelling by.
- many friends and family, including us were looking forward to moving into this area. However, we are very disappointed and even reluctant with the idea of moving into a "new" home where this simple idea of a waste station could bring.

How will the Cumberland City Council monitor and be responsible of the operations of this business? I'd like to strongly emphasise that the proposal for a waste transfer station should not be considered or established.
