I hope this email finds you well. I am writing as a long-term resident in our local area to express my strong objection to the proposed development outlined in DA2023/0130.

The proposed development is located a mere 70 meters from the residential zone and in close proximity to where I live. This proximity greatly amplifies my concerns and further underscores the urgency of my request for a reconsideration of granting approval. Please take into account the following reordered concerns:

The project's pollution and disturbances pose serious health risks, especially to vulnerable groups. Prolonged exposure to traffic-related pollution can result in respiratory and cardiovascular issues.

The increased traffic will lead to air, noise, and soil pollution, as well as unpleasant odors and dust, severely disrupting the tranquility and livability of our suburb.

The proposed project contradicts our vision of a peaceful residential area with thriving commercial and recreational opportunities. It will hinder local businesses and restrict residents' access to recreational

Ongoing heavy vehicle usage related to the development will cause damage to roadworks, I implore you to reconsider granting approval for DA2023/0130. It is crucial to prioritise the long-term well-being, safety, and quality of life of our community.
