Welcome to a putrid organic plant - belong to a community suffocated by stench and traffic gridlock and succeed in lining the pockets of a private company at the expense of our public health and well being - NO NO NO - please no empty slogans - take action and stop this travesty.

The proposed organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street is an outrage, hypocritical and insult to our community.

Council's 2017 - 2027 Strategic Plan states the number 1 goal is to support the health, safety and well-being of our community. A filthy plant processing everything from incontinence pads to food and sludge operating from 6am - 10 pm Mon - Fri and 8am - 6pm Saturday makes a mockery of your number one goal and demonstrates the empty rhetoric common in bureaucracy. The location is in close proximity to residential, schools and aged care making make this proposal even more offensive.

Council also prides itself on improving transport options that are safe and reliable. This plant will bring 120 daily truck movements in an already congested area. At least 20 trucks each night currently park in Church Street and Council are powerless to stop this - fining them does not deter them - please consider towing them away. Imagine the gridlock with 20 meter trucks loaded with organic sludge waiting to turn into the proposed site - expect complete gridlock, jamming under the bridge and a rat run as commuters will attempt to find alternate routes - Rookwood cemetery will become a highway. This is not safe and reliable transport for our community. Please reject this DA asap and ease the stress and anxiety of our community. Please do your job and treat this DA with the same contempt the private developer has done to us.
