My name is I [redacted] and I am writing to express my strong objection to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130.

Lidcombe has already experienced rapid population boom evidently with the rising of apartment blocks been built on both side of the station. This already brought the quiet neighbourhood with increasing traffic and busy roads, particularly the case for John street and Church Street.

If the waste transfer station gets built, this would have significant impact on the many residents currently living in close proximity to the proposed construction site and rest of the neighbourhood with:

1. Increased traffic congestion - with the waste transfer trucks going around.
2. Increase noise pollution
3. Increase dust fumes
4. Increase bad smell and make it uninhabitable for the many residents living close by.
