I strongly object to the proposal for the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492 . File: DA2023/0130 .

My house is located right next to the road. We have already suffered a lot from the engine noise of passing vehicles and that of temporarily stopping heavy vehicles. I have to use ear plug every night just to be able to sleep.

Other than the noise, dust fumes due to the trucks would also significantly increase when the organic waste transfer station is in operation. Not to mention a bad smell from the trucks and plants from the transfer station. I always open windows to enjoy the breeze. Can't leave in a house where I have to shut the window 24 hours. Hope you understand how I feel, please don't take this bit of enjoyment away from me.

To conclude, I strongly object to the mentioned development proposal which could potentially increase the traffic volume, noise and dust on the road, induce bad smells to the neighborhood from trucks and operating plants. For the health and well being of this community, I request that Cumberland Council reevaluate the approval of Development Proposal DA2023/0130.
