Hi,

Please take this email as a formal objection to the development proposal of the rubbish tip in Lidcombe.

As a Lidcombe resident I have witnessed an increasing number of people moving from other suburbs to Lidcombe recently and that is because it is becoming a better and better place to live in, with a number of childcare facilities, restaurants, public parks, and for convenience.

It is totally UNACCEPTABLE that there is a rubbish tip proposal being considered to be built in the centre of Lidcombe's central residential area. There are multiple residential buildings in Lidcombe having its construction finished as we speak, which means there will be even more residents moving into Lidcombe. How does it make sense to build a rubbish tip not even 100m away from residential areas?

Not to mention the Lidcombe residents who are already experiencing concerning levels of traffic, who will now experience more traffic due to increasing number of residents. If the rubbish tip is approved this means that there will be 118 LARGE truck movements every day - Lidcombe's traffic will become even more chaotic.

The apartment I'm current living in experiences a couple minutes of traffic halt in the morning when there is a rubbish truck outside collecting our rubbish weekly. This is the effect of just one rubbish truck per week. If there are 118 rubbish trucks DAILY nearby a number of apartments and a number of houses, no one would be able to get to work on time, get home on time, or be able to take our kids to schools on time.

What about the constant odour that this rubbish tip will cause?

What about the ongoing maintenance that the council will have to do due to a large number of big trucks moving the roads?

This is NOT an appropriate location for a rubbish tip. A rubbish tip should be placed in a completely industrial area FAR AWAY from residential areas, FAR AWAY from the centre of Sydney.
