and my phone number is I am writing in contention of the proposed Organic Waste Transfer Station on 109A Church Street, Lidcombe. Although transfer stations will provide a benefit to the greater Sydney community, I do not believe that the proposed location is a good spot. The proposed location is very small and residential - infrastructure is not set-up suitably and with all the new developments happening in tandem, traffic congestion is already expected. With the development of the transfer station, there will be more congestion as well as consistent damage to the roads due to frequent use by the large rubbish trucks going in and out. For the facility to run effectively without causing trouble to the surrounding residential area, management needs to be impeccable. I do not believe that the council is equipped with the appropriate resources to manage a waste facility in this location adequately. If a transfer station were to be built within the Cumberland council district, there are more appropriate locations such as Chullora Industrial precinct.
